

From I-90

Take West Lake Sammamish / Lakemont Blvd Exit 13 and go south on Lakemont Blvd (Straight up the hill)
On top of the hill go straight through the traffic light and at the stop sign keep to the left (really straight ahead)
Take first **Left** onto SE 62nd After 0.1 miles, (Short separate turn lane, but just before the traffic light)

RIGHT onto 160 Ave SE, which changes name to SE 63rd st

After 0.3 miles, street ends, Stop sign. You will see an A-frame structure for mail boxes. (This is where any GPS will tell you to turn right, don't do that.

LEFT onto 164 Ave SE. and Immediate right (20 feet) up steep gravel drive (left of the mailboxes)
