

One of the featured boats, undergoing restoration by the museum, is the 1973 Pay 'N' Pak. This Unlimited hydroplane is noted for its breakthrough design. It was the first boat to use aluminum honeycomb structure, to feature a pickle fork design, and to have a rear horizontal wing. This resulted in the Pay 'N' Pak becoming the most successful piston powered hydroplane in history.

After our tour of the museum, we will travel up the hill to the home of Don and Joan Andersen, to have a short chapter meeting, pig out at the potluck, and check Studerly, Bab Bryand out Don's latest project. Don always has
