I have some history that comes along with my 1939 coupe too. I have owned it for 44 years. After buying it I drove it for about 6-8 months and then I decided to take it apart and restore it. Technically it has never been back on the road since then. After disassembling most of the car, I went through a divorce, so not much work was done on it for 3-4 years. Then a couple of friends of mine helped me get the restoration moving along. We rebuilt the motor, chassis, painted it and assembled it enough to drive it around the block 3-4 times. At that time more life events got in


